



MEMORANDUM

on mutual cooperation between the General Prosecutor's Office of the Republic of Kazakhstan and Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines Association ALE

February « 4 », 2025

General Prosecutor's Office of the Republic of Kazakhstan hereinafter referred to as "Prosecutor's Office" and **Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines Association ALE** hereinafter referred to as "Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines", guided by the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Constitutional Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Prosecutor's Office", Entrepreneurial Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Subsoil and Subsoil Use", have concluded this Memorandum of Mutual Cooperation.

Article 1

The objectives of this Memorandum are to strengthen interaction and cooperation in the protection of the rights of entrepreneurs and investors, as well as to assist the Parties in creating a favorable and fair business environment and investment climate of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the field of subsoil use.

The Memorandum is concluded in the spirit of partnership and mutual respect on the principles of constructiveness, transparency, efficiency of joint activities and mutual exchange of information and experience.

Article 2

The Parties shall support the development of cooperation by:

- ensuring the legality of the business environment and protecting entrepreneurs from undue administrative pressure and threats of unlawful criminal prosecution;
- identifying and taking measures to eliminate systemic problems and administrative barriers that impede the development of entrepreneurship and improve the investment climate;
- developing and operating a system of advisory and information support for entrepreneurship, establishing a constructive dialog with private business entities;
- development of proposals and legislative initiatives aimed at reducing administrative barriers;
- exchange of information between the Parties;

- development and adoption of joint methodological measures aimed at reducing bureaucratic procedures (including by improving information resources and systems);
- other forms of cooperation within the competence of the Parties.

Article 3

In order to promptly resolve and update problematic issues, realizing the purpose of this Memorandum, the Parties have agreed that in cases of violations of legality and for the purpose of prompt response, interaction will take place on the initiative of the Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines and Mineral Resources through the created chat (WhatsApp) with the participation of entrepreneurs and the responsible officer of the Prosecutor's Office.

Participation of the members of the Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines in such discussions will be on a voluntary basis.

The Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines will send information to the Prosecutor's Office as and when such complaints are received from members of the Kazakhstan Chamber of Mines to the official e-mail of the responsible officer of the Prosecutor's Office.

The parties also agreed that they will promote a favorable and fair business environment and investment climate.

Joint meetings will be held with the participation of representatives of both Parties to discuss and resolve operational issues of business rights protection and to develop measures to eliminate systemic problematic issues.

The Parties have agreed that the meetings will be held at the initiative of one of the Parties at least once a year.

The final document of these meetings will be considered the Minutes of the meeting with a plan for the implementation of jointly developed proposals.

Article 4

The Prosecutor's Office, within its competence, shall study cases of entrepreneurs, and in case of violations of the law, in accordance with the Constitutional Law "On Prosecutor's Office" shall take measures of supervision and response.

If necessary, territorial subdivisions of the Prosecutor's Office and state bodies shall be involved in solving the problems of entrepreneurs.

Article 5

In case of disputes and disagreements in the interpretation and application of the provisions of this Memorandum, the parties shall resolve them through negotiations.

Article 6

This Memorandum of Mutual Cooperation of the Parties may be amended and supplemented, which will be formalized in separate documents that are integral parts of this Memorandum.

Article 7

This Memorandum is drawn up in three languages Kazakh, Russian, English, in case of discrepancies, the text in Russian will prevail.

This Memorandum is concluded for an indefinite period of time, shall enter into force from the date of its signing by each of the Parties and shall remain in force until one of the Parties gives written notice to the other Parties of its intention to terminate the Memorandum.

In such case, the Memorandum shall be deemed terminated from the date of expiration of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of sending of the relevant written notice by one of the Parties.
